The Mediasite Player includes interactive features that help your live online audience engage with your presenters. Using the following template, you can create a customized introduction for your next webcast. By highlighting these tools for your audience, watching a Mediasite presentation is virtually the same as being in the room with the presenter.



Introduction

During the presentation, we'll also ask you to **take a poll**. You can respond by clicking on the pie chart button in the lower right.

This presentation will be available on-demand immediately after by clicking on the same link that you used to watch right now.
