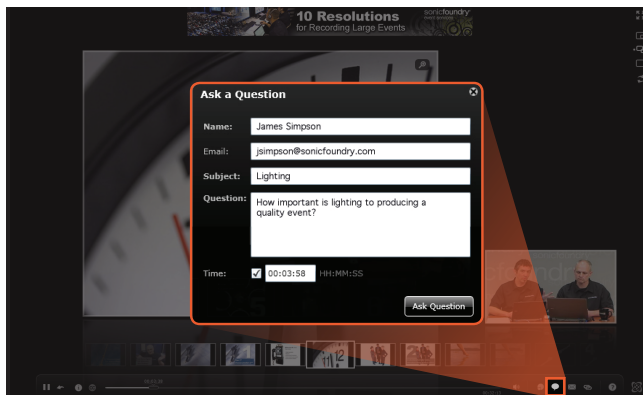


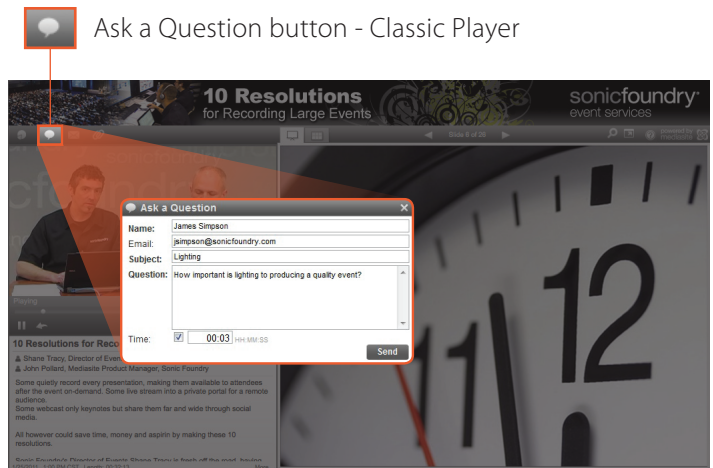
Mediasite Q&A Feature

Asking a question

During a live or on-demand webcast your viewers click the “Ask” button to enter questions which then appear in the moderator’s Q&A panel. Viewers even have the option of including the exact time during the presentation when they submitted their question. For on-demand webcasts, the question feature can be configured to also automatically email the presenter or another individual any questions submitted after the live event.

Moderating questions

All audience questions are sent to the Mediasite Q&A panel. From here the moderator has the option to:

1. Accept questions to share with the speaker verbally during the Q&A portion of the webcast

2. Print accepted questions to share with the speaker

3. Respond to accepted questions via email
